DOG PERMISSION LICENSE

According to the Law on Dogs (Laws L.184 (I) 2002 - L.137 (I) 2005) all dog owners / owners are obliged to obtain a dog ownership permit from the Municipality. To secure this permit, the dog owner, who must be at least 16 years old, must perform the following procedures:

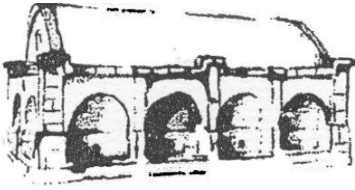
1. Take his dog to a registered veterinarian who:
 - after examining him will issue him a health certificate or booklet.
 - after installing an electronic microchip, it will issue a marking certificate.
2. To present the dog marking certificate to the Department of Veterinary Services and to register his dog in the Dog Register of the Director of the Department to secure the dog registration certificate.
3. To present to the Offices of the Municipality of Pegeia the above certificates together with the certificate or booklet of the dog health from a registered veterinarian.
4. To complete the Application for a dog ownership license.
5. To pay the Dog Permit Fees, which are the following:
 - i. Male dogs, female neutered or not: € 20.50
 - ii. Dangerous breeds of neutered dogs: € 171.00

Dangerous breeds are: Pit Bull Terrier or American Pit Bull, Japanese Tossa, Dogo Argentino, Fila Brasileiro.

Procedures (1) and (2) are performed only once in the dog's life, while procedures (3), (4) & (5) will be performed once a year.

Obligations of a dog owner:

- To keep the dog in good living conditions (in accordance with the Law on Protection and Welfare of Animals) which do not pose a risk to public health, safety and human well-being.
- To ensure his health and to take care of him according to the instructions of the veterinarian.
- Have a sign posted with the warning "CAUTION DOG".
- Do not allow the dog to move freely on a public road / place.
- Take care that the dog does not disturb the neighbors due to barking or dirt (feces) in his area.
- When the dog takes a walk to have him tied with a leash and to collect his dirt (feces).
- Provide adequate shelter and protection from the weather.
- Provide adequate and adequate food and water.
- To offer him suitable opportunities for exercise.
- Take all necessary measures to prevent his escape or escape.
- Do not cause unnecessary pain and suffering to your dog.
- Do not abandon his dog.
- Protect your dog from theft, car accidents and intentional or accidental poisoning.

- To notify the Municipality, with the relevant transfer request of old and new owner, that the dog has been sold or given to another person.
- In such a case that the dog dies to present to the Municipality a death certificate from a registered veterinarian or a responsible statement.

A good place for dog accommodation

- i. It is spacious, safe and allows comfortable movements in the animal.
- ii. It has a suitable roof for protection from rain and sun.
- iii. It has its west and north sides protected from wind currents.
- iv. It has a hard material floor for easy washing and cleaning.
- v. The floor has a slope for water to flow into an absorption pit.
- vi. It has a properly shaped "corner" for sleeping.

The Municipality will file a complaint against those who own a dog without a dog owner license or keep it in violation of the relevant regulations.
